

PRIZE AND AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each STD and JWW and FAST class and 1st place in the T2B class. A green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. A MACH/PACH bar and Rosette will be awarded to each team earning a MACH/PACH. A Rosette will be awarded to each team earning an AGCH. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All awards and prizes must be claimed at the show and none will be mailed.

1st Place: Blue 2nd Place: Red 3rd Place: Yellow 4th Place: White Qualifying Ribbon: Dark Green

RINGSIDE: Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. **All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.**

LIABILITY: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Fargo Moorhead Kennel Club and its agents members, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

ONLINE ENTERIES: This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 165 runs online (50%), 165 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class (es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered in any level (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier, and ICS will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

BEST PRACTICES—Agility Trials

Below is a list of Best Practices for the FM Kennel Club Agility Trial to comply with the CDC and AKC Guidelines. We are committed to providing a safe environment for our exhibitors, workers, and judges!

Crating: Will be available inside the building, social distancing is strongly recommended.

Family groups can crate together either inside or outside. Outdoor crating is available and encouraged. You may setup a pop-up tent if desired or kennel out of your car. There are grassy areas in the back for setup and for exercising dogs.

Building Access: The Main Entrance of the building (North side) will have dedicated entrance and exit doors. Please follow the signs when you arrive.

Check-In: The gate sheets will be posted but only the gate steward may check in your dog. Please practice social distancing when checking in your dog(s) for their run(s). Agility Gate will be used.

Posting Results: Results will be posted on site.

Course Maps: Maps will be posted on site and emailed to exhibitors once available from the Judge.

Walk-Throughs: Decisions will be made to provide enough social distance on course between exhibitors; limited to a maximum of 25 exhibitors/walk-through.

Leashes: There are two options:

Option 1: Leash runner may use a "grabber" if they want to move your leash to the ground by the exit gate.

Option 2: Exhibitor can place the leash in your pocket, around your neck, or around your waist.

NOTE: if the dog grabs the leash while running this will be scored as an "E".

Briefing: General briefing will be provided each day. Delivery will be determined by the judge.

Ribbons/Awards: Ribbons are self-service. Ribbons and labels will be provided for exhibitors.

Communication: During the trial, we understand that people will be spread out and not know what is happening by the ring. After the trial closes, confirmed exhibitors will receive information on how updates will be communicated.

Exhibitors who need services from the show veterinarian during trial hours due to illness or injury, must inform the Red River Animal Emergency Clinic staff that they are attending a Fargo Moorhead Kennel Club dog show.

FOOD: Potluck on Saturday, otherwise food will **not** be available on site for purchase. There are several restaurants within 3 miles of the show site.

CRATING SPACE: Crate in designated areas only. No ex-pens are allowed. Crates may be left overnight; however FM Kennel Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will conform to the current requirements of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

WARM-UPS: Warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or registerable breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements are

Regular Classes

Dogs MAY enter at a higher jump height.
8 inches: 11" or less at the withers
12 inches: 11.12" - 14" at the withers
16 inches: 14.12" - 18" at the withers
20 inches: 18.12" - 22' at the withers
24 inches: More than 22" at the withers
26 inches: Entered at owner's discretion

Preferred Classes

Dogs MAY NOT enter at a higher jump height
4 inches: 11" or less at the withers
8 inches: 11.12" - 14" at the withers
12 inches: 14.12" - 18" at the withers
16 inches: 18.12" - 22" at the withers
20 inches: More than 22" at the withers

REFUNDS: Entry Fees for females that come into season will be refunded (minus a \$12.00 administrative fee per day) prior to the start of judging. Refunds for dogs injured after the closing date will be refunded (minus a \$12.00 administrative fee per day) with a valid veterinary note and written notification received within 24 hours prior to the start of judging. A full refund is to be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by a Wait-Listed entry. Refunds will not be given for refund amounts of \$5 or less. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judge, or banned from competition by action of the trial committee.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Instructions

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
