

## Red River North Dog Obedience Club Floor Use Policy

Club officers, board members and class instructors may use the training center facility for safe and appropriate training for their own dog during times when the facility is not being used for classes, ring time and special events. Please limit time to no more than two hours a week. Use of the facility is a privilege and any violation of the following may result in loss of this privilege.

- Anyone using the obedience or agility equipment must be proficient in how to use the equipment properly and safely. Equipment must be returned to the storage area on the east side of the building. Rally signs and holders are in the cupboards between the entrance and office doors. Do not use the rally signs reserved for our Trials. If there is any damage to equipment, please contact the training director.
- All floor use must be scheduled using the approved online calendar. Scheduled use must end at least 15 - 30 minutes before other scheduled events. Reservations on the calendar may only be made for two weeks at a time.
- If the reserved time is not needed, names must be removed from the online calendar to return the schedule to available for that time slot.
- Names OF **all attendees** of a reserved session must be included in the online calendar.
- Floor time may be reserved for themselves or shared with others. There is no fee required if **all participating** at a given time are club officers, board of directors or instructors.
- Private lessons are only available to students enrolled in RRNDOC Classes. Current Instructors may schedule **one** private class at no cost, for a student needing additional help. If any more are needed, the student probably should repeat the Class. Instructors are encouraged to offer students needing help with before or after class brief meetings.

Floor time should not be used to teach a class. Contact the training director to schedule a class providing there is not already a similar class scheduled or if a scheduled class is full.

- Liability and Covid waivers must be signed and on record for ALL persons using the Training Center.
- Cash and/or checks [payable to RRNDOC] received must be put in the appropriate container in the office along with any signed waivers.
- Scent work or nose work practice is allowed in the RRNDOC Training Center with an Instructor experienced in working with Scents.

## Red River North Dog Obedience Club Instructor Compensation Policy

- All instructors at Red River North Dog Obedience Club are volunteers.
- There is no monetary compensation.

- A seven- week class is available to instructors at no charge for each scheduled seven- week class taught and to our volunteers in key positions, such as, but not limited to Paw Prints Editor and Building Manager..
- The class must be taken within the 12-month period following the session where the scheduled class was taught.
