In Loving Memory of Alice Therapy Dog and Companion of Kerry Lauer Died June 24, 2008

Many of you will remember Alice, the faithful companion and colleague of Kerry Lauer, who attended classes at Red River North for many years. Kerry adopted Alice, who had been abused and abandoned while pregnant.

Alice first came to classes with an attitude, but soon blossomed into a loving and gentle dog under Kerry's tender care. Alice went on to become a certified Therapy Dog with the "Love on a Leash" program offered by the Foundation for Pet Provided Therapy. She was a welcome visitor in local nursing homes. She became a partner with Kerry in her counseling work at the Rape and Abuse Crisis Center in Fargo. She worked at the RACC from 1999 until she "retired" a few months ago. Alice died on June 24, 2008.

Fortunately Kerry has Walter, a sprightly Corgi, to assist her at RACC. He has also been a member of the Red River North's classes. He now works with Kerry at the Center, carrying on Alice's mission of service to people and pets in need.

Alice often worked as the Friendly Dog in RRN's Canine Good Citizen tests. She was always calm and reliable regardless of the exuberance of the other dogs. Everyone loved Alice. We shall all miss her.
