

RRNDOC general meeting 4-19-2010

Meeting called to order at 8:10 PM by President Brian Vail.

President's Report: Printed in "Paw Prints".

<u>Secretary's Report:</u> A motion to approve minutes of the last meeting as published in "Paw Prints" was made by Dave Arnholt and 2nd by Janine Barnestuble. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

<u>Training Directors Report</u>: Lavonne reported that we are in Week 2 of Session III. Class registration is good with 60 dogs registered. The puppy classes are very small. There will be one 7 week session before the trials. Advanced and competitive agility classes had been combined, however, a large registration has made it necessary to separate them again. Denise will teach Foundation at 9 A.M. Saturdays. There will be 3 levels taught on Tuesdays: Beginners (6 PM), Advanced (7 PM) and Competative (8 PM).

<u>Trial Committee:</u> Brian reported that a Chief Obedience Steward and Trial Secretary are still needed. Patti will train a new secretary. Members were reminded that you cannot show a dog if you are secretary. Nancy is looking into ordering ring gating for the trials from J & J at an estimated cost of \$600.00. Brian has found matting from Ludlow Mats. The club will order 12 four by sixty foot mats in June. The cost will be ~ \$2900.00 including shipping and delivery. A motion was made by Dave Arnholt and 2nd by Kathy Wakefield to order additional New Title ribbons for competitors. The old green mats will be disposed of after a notice is sent to the membership to claim donated mats if wanted.

<u>Old Business:</u> Election of officers was made by paper ballot. Denise Luther was elected President, Kris McDonald Secretary for 2 year terms. Elected Board Members at Large were Mary Higdem and Emily Ehalt.

<u>New Business</u>: There was a first reading for Julie Hulne (Miniture Schnauzer).

Kathy L. reported the Club made over \$500.00 from the Herberger's coupon books.

Denise mentioned that Dr. Bauer from Casselton is interested in giving a program for exercises for the performance dogs. She will get find out when Dr. Bauer would be available. Denise also had information on an Ian Dunbar seminar in the Twin Cities October 29-31st. The cost is \$270.00 and a few motel rooms have been set aside for \$85.00 per night. Ian Dunbar is a Veterinary and dog behaviorist.

Brian thanked the Club for their support during his 4 year term as president. He made mention of how there was only \$100.00 in the bank — not even enough to pay the rent when he took office. Denise presented gifts to Brian and Vicki for their service to the Club.
