Training Director's Report

July 2010

The glorious days of summer are here, and we have been enjoying the chance to work outdoors with our dogs. Even though the Training Center is relatively cool when fans are running, it has been nice to move outside for portions of the Obedience classes. The dogs enjoy the new smells and other distractions, and the handlers appreciate the cool evening breezes.

On June 19th Ann Hopp held an Agility Workshop at Mary Lee Warnock's home in Moorhead. The large yard provided ample room to set up an agility course in a safely enclosed space. The weather, which had been temperamental at best, was on its best behavior for the entire day—no rain, cool temperatures and sunny skies. Six handler/dog teams worked from 9 AM to 5 PM, with a short break for lunch. Some non-working dogs spent the day lazing about in their kennels in the shade. Ann set up challenging courses to teach specific handling skills, and coached and critiqued as the handlers ran their dogs. Everyone got a fantastic workout, and dogs and handlers left exhausted, but exhilarated.

I want to express our thanks to Ann for teaching the workshop, and to Mary Lee for giving us the use of her yard. Janine Barnstuble, Denise Luther and her grandson, James, spent the previous day doing yard work in preparation for the workshop. James was especially adept at using the weed-whacker to clear the brush. Mary Lee manicured the lawn with her new John Deere mower!! Everyone helped with cleanup after the workshop. Thank you all! Thanks also to those who contributed food for the lunch and snacks. It was a wonderful day!!

This current session of classes ends on July 17th. We will be on vacation until August 2nd, when we begin a short (5 week) session. We will offer our regular classes on week nights—no classes will be held on Saturdays in August!!
