Presidents Report February 4th, 2011

With each new year comes change, in a few short months we will have our annual meeting,, we will have 3 openings on the Board and with having several new members last year I have decided to use this time to quote our by-laws pertaining to Nominations. I also want to remind everyone that the by-laws and copies of the Paw Prints are on the web site under the members only tab. You will have to have a password to access this page, if anyone needs the password you can contact me and I will email it to you. (sweetpennylane@far.midco.net)

1) Annual Meeting—will be held in the month of April, at this meeting Officers and Directors for the ensuing year shall be elected by secret ballot for those nominated in accordance with Section 4 of this Article.

Section 4. Nominations.

No person may be a candidate in a club election who has not been nominated. During the month of January, the board shall select a Nominating Committee consisting of three members and two alternates, not more than one of whom may be a member of the Board. The Secretary shall immediately notify the committee members and their alternates of their selection. The Board shall name a chairman for the committee and it shall be such a person's duty to call a committee meeting, which shall be held on or before January 31st.

- A) The committee shall nominate one candidate for each office and open position on the Board and, after securing the consent of each person so nominated, shall immediately report their nominations to the Secretary in writing.
- B) Upon receipt of the Nominating Committee's report, the Secretary shall, at least two weeks before the March meeting, notify each member in writing of the candidates so nominated.
- C) Additional nominations may be made at the March meeting by any member in attendance, provided that the person so nominated does not decline when their name is proposed, and provided further that if the proposed candidate is not in attendance at the meeting, the proposer shall present to the Secretary a written statement from the proposed candidate signifying willingness to be a candidate. (No person may be a candidate for more than one position.)
- D) Nominations cannot be made at the annual meeting or in any manner other than as provided in this Section.

One more important part of the process, No member may vote whose dues are not paid for the current year.
