Meeting called to order at 8:10 PM by President Denise Luther.

President's Report: In "Paw Prints".

<u>Secretary's Report:</u> A motion to approve minutes of the last meeting as published in "Paw Prints" was made by Janine and 2nd by Sandy. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Financials were in last Paw Prints.

<u>Training Director:</u> Lavonne asked members to spread the word about the upcoming CGC testing October 23. The preliminary schedule is out for the next session. An Hopp will be teaching an Agility Foundation class on Saturdays. Instructor permission is required. Students must be dedicated and willing to compete. The bylaws were checked to make sure instructing her own students for a fee in the same class is not in conflict.

Old Business: Income this year was way down. Expenses went up 12%. Show expenses were up as well. Class fees will need to be raised in 2012.
