Avoid strenuous exercise on extremely hot days. Take walks in the early mornings or evenings, when the sun's heat is less intense.

Don't let your dog overdo it swimming; it is very hard work and he may tire quickly.

Try to avoid prolonged exposure to hot asphalt or sand, which can burn your dog's paws.

Keep dogs off of lawns that have been chemically treated or fertilized for 24 hours (or according to package instructions), and away from potentially toxic plants and flowers.

Dogs, especially those with short hair, white fur, and pink skin, can sunburn. Limit your dog's exposure during the day and apply sunblock to his ears and nose 30 minutes before going outside.



Follow these tips to ensure your cookout doesn't upset your canine.

- Be sure your dog is wearing a visible and up-todate ID tag on her collar before the party begins.
- Keep charcoal, matches and lighter fluid away from your dog.
- Consider keeping your pup on a leash so she doesn't explore hot grills or tables of food.
- While grilling, ask guests to play with your dog far from the flames.
- Place citronella and other insect-repellants where your dog can't reach them.

- · Never leave alcohol unattended around dogs.
- Check that all sunscreen or insect repellant you apply to your dog is labeled for use on pets.
- Don't let guests give your pup people food.
 Consider having a bag of treats on hand.
- Be sure all children are supervised when near your dog to avoid any roughhousing.
- If your pup seems overwhelmed, bring her inside and put her in a quiet area away from guests.

More Summer Safety

NEVER LEAVE A DOG IN YOUR CAR!

- A car's temperature will rise approximately 40°F in an hour even on a relatively cool, 72°F day*
- Most of that temperature increase is within the first 30 minutes.*
- Cracking your windows doesn't stop the heat from rising.*
- · Cars can reach 120°F in a matter of minutes on a hot day.
- Dogs can succumb to heatstroke even when the car is in the shade.
- Leaving the air conditioning on and the car running doesn't guarantee your dog's safety.
- Leave your dog at home on hot days or find alternate ways to run your errands.



The signs of heatstroke include:

- Excessive or exaggerated panting
- Lethargy
- Weakness
- Drooling

- High fever
- Dark red gums
- Rapid heartbeat
- Unresponsiveness to commands and surroundings
- Vomiting
- Collapse
- · Staring/anxious expression
- Warm/dry skin

Pettinder Summer Pet Safety

If you think your dog may have heatstroke, head straight to your vet's office. It could save his life!

- Diarrhea Tablets
- Bandage
- Scissors
- Cotton
- Gauze
- Tape
- Muzzle
- Large and small tweezers
- Disposable razors
- Nail clippers for dogs
- Thermometer (rectal)
- Safety pins

- Clean fabric of different widths
- Instant cold compresses
- Elastic to wrap around bandages
- Antiseptic cleansing wipes
- Sterile saline eye wash
- Alcohol prep pads
- Small bottle hydrogen peroxide
- Antihistamine tablets (such as Benadryl)
- Antiseptic anesthetic spray (such as Bactine)
- Bacitracin antibiotic ointment
- Spare leash and collar
- Mirror
- Pen, pencil and paper
