## Dog Demonstration / Meet \& Greets

There are no further demos scheduled for this year. Watch Paw Prints and for sign up sheets at the club for future demos.

We invite you to join us on Thursday afternoons from 1：00 to 3：00 PM for a chance to work with your dog on Obedience or Rally skills．

There will be two rings available for practice．You may reserve a spot for 30 minutes for $\$ 5$ ．

This is not a formal class，but an instructor will be available to answer questions．

Decorations: Keep decorations (lit candles, streamers, jack-o-lanterns, exposed electrical cords) out of your dog's reach. Ingesting these items could mean a costly visit to the vet clinic.

Candy: Keep the candy bowl and treat bags out of your dog's reach. The canine digestive system is not adapted for sweet candy and chocolate contains Theobromine, which can be fatal.

Costumes: Children in costumes may frighten your dog. If you dress your dog up, make sure he is comfortable. Make sure that the costume does not restrict your dog's movement or hearing, or impede his ability to breathe or bark. If your dog is opposed to wearing a costume, you could dress him up with a holiday bandana.

Walks: Take your walk while it is still light out so that you can see what is on the ground in front of you, as your dog may find candy or wrappers.

Collar and ID Tags: Be sure that your dog is wearing his collar and ID tags. With the door opening and closing all the time, there is a greater chance for your dog to escape. If possible, use a baby gate to block off the area in front of the door to keep your dog from getting out.

Safe Haven: If your dog becomes stressed with all the strangers coming to the door, the doorbell ringing all the time, kids screaming, etc. Consider keeping him in his crate or in a separate room. Turn on the television or play some music to help drown out the noise. Also consider a natural pheromone spray that can help relax your dog.

Outside: Do not leave your dog outside unattended, even in a fenced yard. Pranksters may taunt your dog or cause him harm. Plus all the people in costumes may cause your dog a lot or stress.


Equipment Needed: Buckle, Martingale, or Slip-chain collar. Harnesses permitted. A regular leather or woven 6 foot leash. Your dog's brush or comb.

Not Allowed: Prong collars, Electronic collars, Special training harnesses (including NO Jump, NO Pull, Reduce Pulling, etc.) or Retractable leashes.
