## Training Director's Report, October 2015

### New Classes Session VI October 28 (W) thru December 19, 2015

The final session of classes for 2015 will begin in a few weeks. We will start in mid-week just before Halloween and end a week before Christmas. [See attached schedule] We have scheduled a break over the Thanksgiving holiday to give everyone a chance to enjoy the time with family and friends.

The <u>Pet Partners Therapy Dog Handler Class</u> will not be held this session. Look for the next class sometime in 2016. <u>Agility Foundation</u> class will move indoors this session after being held outdoors during the summer. The date and time of the class will be announced soon.

All the classes fill up fast—so be sure to pre-register for the class of your choice!

#### **Canine Good Citizen Test**

We will be holding a <u>Canine Good Citizen test on Sunday</u>, <u>November 22, 2015</u> at the Training Center. Canine Good Citizen is a bit like "Miss Manners for Dogs" because we work together with our dogs to make them considerate, confident and composed in different social situations. Many of you have worked in obedience classes, and have mastered all the skills needed to pass the ten items on the test. If you have never tested with your dog I would encourage you to give it a try in November. We offer instruction on the CGC test items in our Advanced Beginners class on Wednesday nights. Come join us if you need a Refresher!

#### **Dog Demonstrations**

The final Dog Demo of the year was held at Villa Maria on Friday, October 16<sup>th</sup>. In previous years we have gone to Bethany at University, Bethany at 42<sup>nd</sup>, and Villa Maria in Fargo; Golden Living Center in Moorhead; and Viking Manor in Ulen, MN. This year we were also invited to Rosewood on Broadway in Fargo, and Eventide in Moorhead. It has been great fun for us to bring our dogs to local nursing homes. ### Ring Practice Time

### Halloween Safety

<u>Decorations:</u> Keep decorations (lit candles, streamers, jack-o-lanterns, exposed electrical cords) out of your dog's reach. Ingesting these items could mean a costly visit to the vet clinic.

<u>Candy:</u> Keep the candy bowl and treat bags out of your dog's reach. The canine digestive system is not adapted for sweet candy and chocolate contains Theobromine, which can be fatal.

<u>Costumes:</u> Children in costumes may frighten your dog. If you dress your dog up, make sure he is comfortable. Make sure that the costume does not restrict your dog's movement or hearing, or impede his ability to breathe or bark. If your dog is opposed to wearing a costume, you could dress him up with a holiday bandana.

**Walks:** Take your walk while it is still light out so that you can see what is on the ground in front of you, as your dog may find candy or wrappers.

<u>Collar and ID Tags:</u> Be sure that your dog is wearing his collar and ID tags. With the door opening and closing all the time, there is a greater chance for your dog to escape. If possible, use a baby gate to block off the area in front of the door to keep your dog from getting out.

<u>Safe Haven:</u> If your dog becomes stressed with all the strangers coming to the door, the doorbell ringing all the time, kids screaming, etc. Consider keeping him in his crate or in a separate room. Turn on the television or play some music to help drown out the noise. Also consider a natural pheromone spray that can help relax your dog.

Outside: Do not leave your dog outside unattended, even in a fenced yard. Pranksters may taunt your dog or cause him harm. Plus all the people in costumes may cause your dog a lot or stress.
