#### TRAINING DIRECTOR'S REPORT-STEVIE MATHRE

Session 4 is well under way, and going well. Classes have been filling up, and we've even had to add an extra puppy class on Monday afternoon to help with overflow.

Welcome to a couple new teaching assistants: Theresa Toikka-Jensen and Ali Porath are helping out in Monday night's beginning obedience class, which Denise is teaching. It's been a while since Denise has taught a class, and she's been doing a stellar job with a class that's often the toughest to teach, with dogs and handlers at different levels of experience and training. Thank you and welcome!

Our schedule for Session 5 is ready to go!

Ann Hopp will be teaching a new agility class on building teamwork and playing agility games. That will be on Mondays at 5:00 pm.

We've got two new instructors starting next session: Mary Higdem will be teaching Advanced Beginners and Novice on Wednesday nights. Richie Selden will teach agility, and we'll get an updated agility schedule out as soon as possible. Mary and Richie have been teaching in Moorhead until recently, and we welcome them and their students to Red River North. Their classes are open to all, not just those who have been training with them already.

Our three-week classes have been a success, so if you have a topic you're interested in, let me know! Winter is a great time for creative, low-commitment, topical classes. I'm always willing to help create a curriculum, and it's a great way to share your skills or try out instructing a class.

We're also looking into some creative ways to expand our teaching opportunities to better reach the community. Anyone who is interested in demonstrating basic exercises, or helping run a camera, or editing video, please contact me! I have developed a virtual class format, which will allow us to continue training even if we have to shut down again, and provide options in scheduling. I would like to launch one beginners obedience class to begin with, starting in January. That means the rest of this year will be busy with filming clips for class. So if you are intrigued, let me know. We'll need people and dogs to show how to perform skills, help with production, and teach the classes once we launch. It's not a self-study model, so students and instructors will still be committing to a day and time while working together on-line.

Masking and social distancing have been good additions to our program to keep everyone safe and healthy. The dogs benefit as well, because as everyone proceeds directly to the training area, and there's less crowding and waiting. Current pandemic conditions don't allow us to forego the masks, and with winter approaching, I don't anticipate being able to relax on mask-wearing any time soon. Students have been very willing to participate in our safety procedures. Thank you to everyone who has been helping wipe down chairs and surfaces, vacuuming the floor, and maintaining safe practices.

Because we're using both doors regularly, please confirm they are both locked when leaving the building, and all the fans and lights are off.

Thank you to everyone who has made our re-opening run smoothly. It's good to get back in the groove, and see students come learn with their dogs.

Our website provides access to our information without the need to join Facebook.

Our Facebook page contains information about our club, classes, class schedule, photos, and articles of interest to the dog community. People can click on like/following to become a fan and get updates. RRNDOC gets statistics on people liking our page.

To join, click on the join button and answer the questions:

- 1. What is your relationship with RRNDOC such as member, instructor, taking classes, competitor?
- 2. Do you agree to post only dog related material and no spam, chain letters and understand that If material is considered inappropriate by the administrators it will be deleted?
- 3. Are you currently training or competing with a dog and if so what events?

Not every join request is approved as it may be more appropriate to follow our public Facebook page or access our website. Some examples are people who are new to dog training and looking for class information, people who don't own a dog at present, confusion that we are not referring to the Texas Red River Group, and obvious trolls.

A Facebook private group is the place for club members and friends of our club to share dog related information, including show wins, articles of interest, concerns, common interests, post photos, access premium lists and class schedules in the file section which are in PDF format, ask questions, and comment on a post. Please include the name of the show when posting a win. The three dots in the upper right corner of a post gives you options such as editing or deleting your post, turn on or turn off notifications for the post when people comment, and saving and organizing posts for future reference.

Since our garage sale is postponed due to Covid-19, classified ads are allowed only if 1) not excessive 2) dog related items or 3) non-dog related items if the entire proceeds go to RRNDOC for our building fund and other expenses. In your post be sure to add the hashtag, #classad so all advertising can be easily grouped and the note that proceeds will go to RRNDOC if a non-dog related item.

The banner photo of member dogs at the top of the page is changed every week or so. If you send me your photo via email or Facebook personal message (PM) your dog will have a turn as our banner dog. The photos do not have to be show wins. Casual photos such as when hiking and enjoying the fall colors, time at the lakes, or even cuddling on the sofa are most welcome.

Many RRNDOC club members are also members of the Fargo-Moorhead Kennel Club which also has a website, public Facebook page and a private group.

Our presence on the internet and the Paw Prints newsletter help us with better communication which is a priority for our club. Suggestions, concerns, and corrections are welcome.


